Things to Know

- Sacramento native Cameron Champ opens up 3-stroke lead, one shy of Safeway Open record for 54 holes
- Sebastian Munoz poised to become the first player to win back-to-back events since Bryson DeChambeau in 2018
- The lone PGA TOUR victory for three of the top four on the leaderboard is the Sanderson Farms Championship
- 36-hole leader Bryson DeChambeau shoots a 4-over 76 and is 0-for-5 in his career with the 36-hole lead/co-lead

- Three-stroke lead falls one-stroke shy of the 54-hole record, held by Sangmoon Bae (2014/won)
- In the 2018 Safeway Open, Brandt Snedeker led by three strokes after 54 holes before finishing T2
- One of just four players without a bogey in round three
- Only other occasion on which he held a 54-hole lead on the PGA TOUR, converted for the win at last season's Sanderson Farms Championship
- Leads the field in Driving Distance (335.3 yards), Scrambling (11 of 12), Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (5.868) and Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green (10.936)
- In two previous Safeway Open starts, missed the cut in 2017 and finished T25 last season
- Won the Sanderson Farms Championship and advanced to the BMW Championship as a rookie in 2018-19, finishing the season No. 62 in the FedExCup standings
- Born in Sacramento and attended Heritage Peak Charter School

Sebastian Munoz (T2/-11)

- Winner of last week's Sanderson Farms Championship and current FedExCup points leader
- Seeking his third consecutive top-10 finish, Munoz finished T7 at the season-opening A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier
- His 67 in round three this week extended his perfect streak of sub-par rounds this season to 11
- With a win Sunday, would become the first player to win in consecutive weeks on the PGA TOUR since Bryson DeChambeau at the 2018 THE NORTHERN TRUST and Dell Technologies Championship
- In only previous Safeway Open start, missed the cut in 2018 following scores of 69-76
- Is making his 48th career start on the PGA TOUR

Adam Hadwin (T2/-11)

- One of two Canadians at T2 (Nick Taylor); both seeking a second PGA TOUR title
- One of just four players without a bogey in round three
- In five previous Safeway Open Starts, only top-40 finish was a T7 in his first start in 2011 at CordeValle Golf Club in San Martin, California
- This week's Safeway Open marks his first start of the 2019-20 season
- Lone PGA TOUR victory came at the 2017 Valspar Championship

Nick Taylor (T2/-11)

- Through 54 holes, ranks fourth in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (3.563)
- Making his sixth consecutive start in the Safeway Open. Following missed cuts from 2014-16, finished T9 in 2017 and T53 last season
- Making his third start of the season (T24/A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier, MC/Sanderson Farms Championship)
- Lone PGA TOUR title came at the 2014 Sanderson Farms Championship
- Lone top-10 finish in 2018-19 on the PGA TOUR, a T9, came with partner Martin Laird at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans

Miscellaneous Notes

- Bryson DeChambeau (T15/-8), who made eight birdies in round two to take a 2-stroke lead, shot a 4-over 76 and is 0-for-5 in his career with the 36-hole lead/co-lead
- Collin Morikawa, who made PGA TOUR debut as an amateur at the 2016 Safeway Open (MC), sits T5 at 10-under 206
- Following his opening-round 7-under 65 to hold a share of the 18-hole lead, Adam Scott (T36/-5) followed with back-toback 73s in rounds two and three
- Recent U.S. Walker Cup team representative Isaiah Salinda stands T47 at 3-under 213 in his PGA TOUR debut this week
