Things to Know

- Brendon Todd holds 36-hole lead/co-lead for the third time on TOUR on search of his third victory this season
- Five-time PGA TOUR winner Rickie Fowler, two strokes off the lead, seeks his first World Golf Championships title
- After tying his career-best score with a first-round 62, Brooks Koepka shoots 1-over 71 and sits T3
- Chez Reavie has made one bogey through 36 holes, tied with Xander Schauffele and Brendon Todd for fewest in the field

- Posts bogey-free 5-under 65; currently tied with Bryson DeChambeau for most rounds of 65 or lower this season (10)
- Marks his third 36-hole lead/co-lead; has converted previous two attempts to victory (2019 Bermuda Championship; 2014 AT&T Byron Nelson)
- Has made 263 feet, 5 inches of putts through first two rounds, marking his second-most feet of putts made through the opening two rounds of an event in his TOUR career
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (6.832) and T1 in Sand Saves (2/2)

- In search of his first World Golf Championships title and third TOUR win this season
- One of three players with multiple wins during the 2019-20 season (Todd/2, Webb Simpson/2, Justin Thomas/2)

Rickie Fowler (2nd/-9)

- In his only two previous appearances at TPC Southwind, he finished T13/2014 FedEx St. Jude Classic and missed the cut at 2017 FedEx St. Jude Classic
- Marks his 30th start in a World Golf Championships with his best finish (T2) in 2011 at this event when it was held at Firestone Country Club
- Seeks first top-10 finish since T10 at the American Express Championship in January, a span of 10 events. The last time he played 10 or more consecutive events without a top-10 finish was five tournaments at the end of the 2011 season and first five of 2012 season
- Five-time PGA TOUR winner in search of his first World Golf Championships title and first win on the PGA TOUR since the 2019 Waste Management Phoenix Open

Additional Player Notes

- Defending champion **Brooks Koepka** (T3) Strokes Gained: Putting (-4.621) marks third-worst of career (-5.388/R3 round/2018 Sentry Tournament of Champions; -5.114/R1/2015 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- **Byeong Hun An** (T3/-7) has one top-10 in 14 previous starts in World Golf Championships events (T9/2016 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play); An's career-best PGA TOUR finish: T2/three times (most recent: 2018 RBC Canadian Open)
- **Chez Reavie** (T3/-7) has made one bogey through 36 holes, tied with **Xander Schauffele** and **Brendon Todd** for fewest in the field; Reavie won the 2019 Travelers Championship and went on to finish the season No. 8 in the FedExCup standings (No. 92 in 2019-20)
- Korea's **Sung Kang** (T6) currently ranks second in field for Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (5.691); in search of his first World Golf Championships title
- England's **Matthew Fitzpatrick** (T6) sank 112 feet, 3 inches of putts in round one and 104 feet, 3 inches in round two (216' 6"). Opened with scores of 70-64 – 134 (-6). Seeks first career PGA TOUR victory.
