Ben Griffin (T1/-11)

- Second 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; 0-for-1 to date (2023 Sanderson Farms Championship; finished T2)
- 11-under 129 equals his best opening 36-hole score on TOUR (2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship; finished T3)
- 18th start of the season where he has notched five top-10 finishes (T7/The American Express, T4/Mexico Open at VidantaWorld, T4/Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches, Won/Zurich Classic of New Orleans/with teammate Andrew Novak, T8/PGA Championship)
- Second round 63 tops season-low PGA TOUR round in individual stroke play by two strokes (previous: 65/R4/Texas Children's Houston Open)
- Making his third consecutive start at the Charles Schwab Challenge (T52/2023, MC/2024)

Matti Schmid (T1/-11)

- Cards a bogey-free second-round 63 in his second appearance at the Charles Schwab Challenge (MC/2024); marks his 15th career bogey-free round in 215 total rounds on TOUR (most recent: 2025/R1/The American Express)
- Holds the 36-hole lead/co-lead for the third time on TOUR; 0-for-2 to date (2022 ISCO Championship/T8, 2024 Shriners Children's Open/T3)
- Making his 79th start on TOUR and seeking his first career win (best finishes: 2024 Shriners Children's Open/T3, 2023 Butterfield Bermuda Championship/3rd)

Additional Player Notes

- After posting his career-low PGA TOUR score (63) in the first round, **John Pak** (3rd/-9) trails by two entering the third round; only top-25 finish in 27 career starts came at the 2025 Mexico Open at VidantaWorld (T17)
- Chris Gotterup (4th/-8), who owns one victory in 56 starts on TOUR (2024 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic), cards rounds of 67-65 in his second start at the Charles Schwab Challenge after missing the cut with rounds of 76-70 in his 2024 debut; has finished in the top 20 in each of his last four starts on TOUR (best: T12/Zurich Classic of New Orleans/with teammate Quade Cummins)
- Making his 12th start at the Charles Schwab Challenge, Rickie Fowler's (T7/-6) 29 on his opening nine holes of round two equals his best nine-hole score on TOUR, set four times previously and most recently at the 2025 Truist Championship (R1/front-nine)
- World No. 1 and last week's PGA Championship winner **Scottie Scheffler** (T49/-1) makes the cut for his 55th consecutive made cut on TOUR, second only to Xander Schauffele who holds the longest active streak on TOUR with 64
- 2016 Charles Schwab Challenge champion and 13-time PGA TOUR winner Jordan Spieth (T62/E) cards second-round 1over 71 to make the cut on the number; has eight top-10s in 12 starts at the event, four more than any other player since 2013

- Defending champion Davis Riley (+2) misses the cut by two strokes
- Champions' Choice selections Neal Shipley (+1) and Blades Brown (+3) missed the cut
