Notable

• At 7,670 yards the course ranks just behind Torrey Pines (7,765) as are as length of courses played on tour so far this year.

- The 94 bunkers are second only to Pebble Beach (116) so far this year on tour.
- Maintenance volunteers come from La Cana Golf Course, the area and internationally.
- There are plans for a bunker renovation.

• The property is very rocky and had low vegetation and no soil at all before construction. Eighteen inches of sand was laid for the golf course.

• More than half of the maintenance staff has been at the course since construction.

• The golf course is part of the Puntacana Ecological Foundation program for conservation of the Ridgway's Hawk, a native of Hispaniola Island.
